**Kiddush levana for Sephardim and Edot Hamizrach:** From Tuesday night 8 Adar I (8.2.2022)

**1 Rosh Chodesh Adar I, Tuesday 30 Shvat (1.2.2022).** Davening for Rosh Chodesh according to the custom.

**2 Rosh Chodesh Adar I, Wednesday 1 Adar I (2.2.2022).** Rosh Chodesh davening according to the custom.

## Shabbat Parashat Vayakhel, 25 Adar I (26.2.2022). Parashat Shkalim

Two *sifrei Torah* are taken out. Seven *aliyot* from *parashat hashavua* are read in the first *sefer*. Half *kaddish*. *Maftir* is read in the second *sefer* from *parashat Ki Tisa*, *Shemot perek 30 psukim 11-16* from the beginning of the *parsha* until *al nafshotechem*. *Haftorah* is read from *Melachim II perek 12 psukim 1-17*, *Ben sheva shanim*. It is customary not to call up a child for the *maftir*. Bless the new month of *Adar II*, which falls on Thursday and Friday (3-4.3.2022). *Av harachamim* and *El maleh rachamim* are not said.

**The Molad: Thursday early morning (3.3.2022) at 03:51 a.m. (and 17 *chalakim*).**

**Mincha.** Three *aliyot* from *parashat Pekudei*. *Tzidkatcha tzedek* is said.

**Wednesday, 29 Adar I (2.3.2022), Erev Rosh Chodesh Adar II.**

Those who fast on *erev Rosh Chodesh* say *Yom Kippur katan*, *tachanun* is not said at *mincha*.

**Thursday, 30 Adar I (3.3.2022), first day of Rosh Chodesh Adar II.** Davening for *Rosh Chodesh*.
